

Steps for setting up your site in Dreamweaver using SFTP connection

ABC site:

1. Create a folder on your desktop (example, name it **abc-LOCAL**)
2. Open Dreamweaver and in the top menu bar click "**Site**", "**New Site**".
In the popup screen under "Site" in the left menu, make Site name be **STS**.
Under Local Site Folder, navigate to the folder on your desktop named **sts-LOCAL**.

In the left menu under "**Servers**", click the + sign to add a server.
Then in that popup, under the **Basic tab**, type the following:

Server Name: glue.umd.edu
Connect using: SFTP
SFTP address: glue.umd.edu
Username: (enter your umd username)
Password: (enter your umd password)

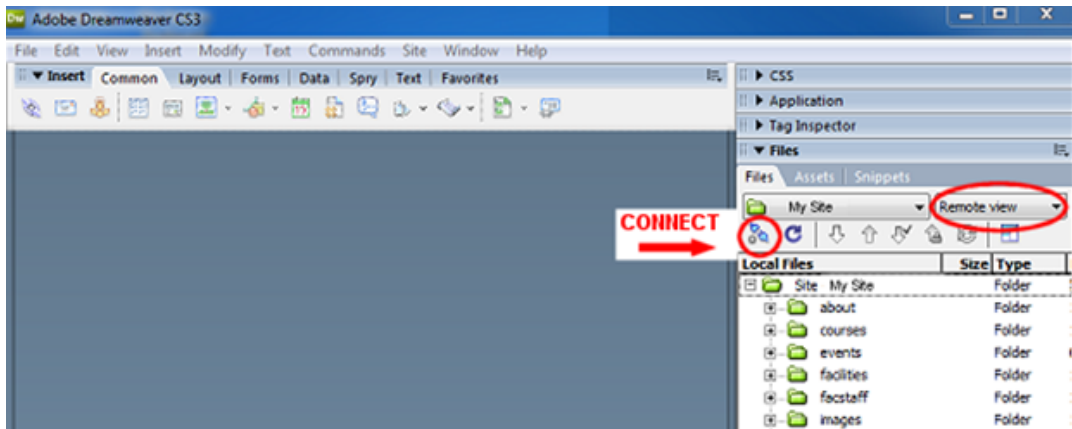
Test: skip for the moment. Do not connect yet.

Example Root Directory: /afs/glue.umd.edu/department/engr/web/sts

URL: http://www.sts.umd.edu

Test: Click the Test button to test the connection. If it connects OK, click Save.

Save again. No other setting need to be done for ftp.



4. In the right column under the **Files tab** in Dreamweaver, to the **right of your site name**, click "**Remote Server**". That will connect to the site. If you are going to strictly work directly on the remote server, then that's it. Your site is now set up in Dreamweaver.

Continue to next page ...

5. No other software is required to connect to the sites.

Notes:

These instructions are for **Dreamweaver 5 and above**. If you are using another version, your screen may look slightly different, but the info you enter is the same.

IF YOUR CONNECTION DOES NOT WORK:

Sometimes you need to enter an alternate server name in "Server Name" and in SFTP Address" area.

You can try **compute.eng.umd.edu** or **analyze.umd.edu**, instead of glue.umd.edu

But **do not change the root directory path**.
